

Modern Slavery Statement 2016

OnePlastics is committed to a slavery free company and supply chain which excludes forced or involuntary labour, human trafficking, and child labour. Our code of conduct states that every employee has the responsibility to abide by laws and regulations with no manager authorised to instruct an employee to commit an unethical or illegal act. As an employer OnePlastics is committed to the application of equal opportunity, good conditions of employment, and providing a workplace that is safe and secure.

As a global purchaser of raw materials we demand that all suppliers must comply with regulation and laws prohibiting slavery and human trafficking plus promote good labour practices and human rights policies. We will not tolerate any illegal activities and take appropriate measures to ensure our suppliers meet these standards.

Our code of conduct makes our management teams responsible for compliance with laws and regulations. Should our employees become aware of illegal or improper activities then our Whistleblower Policy is intended to assist employees who believe they have discovered a malpractice to come forward.
